SJM co-hosted 2024 PATA Annual Summit Draws to Successful Close in Macau

(Macau, 17 May 2024) The "Pacific Asia Travel Association Annual Summit 2024" a notable event in the regional tourism calendar, concluded successfully from 15-17 May at the Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau.
