SJM Triumphs at the Prestigious Star Wine List of the Year Asia 2024

(Macau, 29 May 2024) SJM Resorts, S.A. is honoured to announce that it has once again exemplified Macau's excellence on the global stage at the 2024 Star Wine List of the Year Asia awards. Robuchon au Dôme and Don Alfonso 1890, two of SJM's renowned culinary gems, were the only shortlisted finalists from Macau, with each nominated in three categories. Robuchon au Dôme has triumphantly clinched the top spot Gold Star on the "Best Long List" and entered into the International Final. The award-winning wine list is described as "a great list with fine wine collection that is rarely seen in Asia" by one of the jurors. In its inaugural nomination, Don Alfonso 1890 is also awarded a Silver Star on the "Best Long List," "Best California Wine List," and "Best Newcomer List."

An award ceremony held today in Hong Kong unveiled the coveted list of winners, attended by a distinguished crowd from the international wine community. SJM is profoundly honoured to be the only finalist from Macau, thereby showcasing its status as a "Creative City of Gastronomy" and solidifying its position on Asia's culinary map.

SJM's wine program, along with our efforts in sommelier training, has long been recognised as one of the best in Asia. The Star Wine List of the Year awards, established in 2018, have become one of the global benchmarks for wine list excellence. Initially launched in the Nordics, the awards now celebrate the finest wine lists across major markets, including London, New York, and Asia. These awards recognise outstanding wine lists across various categories, judged by esteemed sommeliers, and have grown to be one of the most prestigious accolades in the wine industry. The Asian edition, introduced in 2023, has further highlighted the region's growing prominence in the global wine scene.

SJM boasts one of the world's finest wine cellars, carrying more than 17,600 varieties of fine wines and housing nearly 500,000 bottles. In 2023, Robuchon au Dôme was named winner of the Grand Prix List and Best California Wine List, while Don Alfonso 1890 was nominated as a finalist for the first time in the 2024 edition.
