The 2024 CTA Tour “SJM” Professional Finals (Macau) and National Tennis Championships Conclude Successfully

(Macau, November 24, 2024) The highly anticipated 2024 CTA Tour “SJM” Professional Finals (Macau) and National Tennis Championships concluded successfully on November 24 in Macau. The grand tennis celebration attracted numerous enthusiasts and sports fans, with champions crowned across four categories during this prestigious event.

The men’s singles final, the highlight of the tournament, saw Bu Yunchaokete defeat Bai Yan in straight sets, 6-4, 6-1, to claim the championship title, while Bai Yan finished as runner-up. In the women’s singles final, Liu Fangzhou triumphed over Zheng Wushuang, winning 6-4, 6-4, to secure the title, leaving Zheng Wushuang as runner-up.

Following the men’s singles final, an award ceremony was held, attended by esteemed guests including Mr. Luís Gomes, President of the Sports Bureau of the Macao SAR Government; Ms. Daisy Ho, Managing Director of SJM Resorts, S.A.; and Mr. Wei Weige, Chairman of Beijing China Tennis Management Co., Ltd.

In the men’s doubles, the team of Zheng Zhan and Tang Sheng faced Yang Zijiang and Zheng Baoluo, with Yang and Zheng emerging victorious in straight sets, 6-1, 6-4, to clinch the title. For the women’s doubles, Xu Yifan and Yang Zhaoxuan defeated the pair of Guo Hanyu and Zheng Saisai, winning 7-5, 6-3, to claim the championship.

The “Champions Night” Award Presentation Ceremony was held at the Jardim Secreto of Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau, commemorating the players' outstanding achievements. Officiating guests included Mr. Luís Gomes, President of the Sports Bureau of the Macao SAR Government; Ms. Bai Bing, Deputy Director of the Division of Culture and Sports of the Department of Publicity and Culture of the Liaison Office of the Central People's Government in the Macao SAR; Mr. Timothy Fok, Chairman of the Board of Directors of SJM Resorts, S.A.; Ms. Angela Leong, Director of SJM Resorts, S.A.; Ms. Ng Ioc Leng, President of the Macau Tennis Association; Mr. Wei Weige, Chairman of Beijing China Tennis Management Co., Ltd.; Mr. Li Li, Head of Sports Programs at International (Shanghai) Media Harbor; Mr. Peng Lingchang, General Manager of Beijing CTA Tour Sport Management Co., Ltd; Mr. Wu Chun, CTA Finals Ambassador; and special guests included Ms. Guo Luoyao, bronze medalist in wheelchair women's doubles at the Paris Paralympics; Ms. Zhu Zhenzhen, runner-up in wheelchair women's singles at the 2024 French Open; Ms. DongFuli, Head Coach of the National Wheelchair Tennis Team; Mr. Pan Bing, gold medalist in men’s singles at the Asian Games, as well as fellow competitors at the tournament.

Champions were also invited to visit the “Glory of Chinese Tennis Exhibition” at the East Lobby of Grand Lisboa Palace, where they explored the journey of Chinese tennis through history, relived significant milestone, and celebrated the achievements and progress that was made.

This year’s CTA Championships featured a variety of extended activities, including the “Glory of Chinese Tennis Exhibition”, the inspiring sharing session “Dialogues with Outstanding Athletes” and a series of “Tennis for All” themed events, such as the Macau Special Olympics Interaction Camp, Fans Meet-And-Greet event, and the Celebrity and Elite Players Exhibition Match. These activities aimed at promoting tennis across various sectors of society, allowing the city to experience the excitement and passion for the sport. With the conclusion of this year’s successful tournament, fans eagerly anticipate the return of the CTA Championships to Macau in 2025. It will once again bring together enthusiasts to witness the rise of new stars. May all players continue to achieve great success in future competitions and contribute to the growth and development of tennis in China.
