SJM Honoured with 10 Awards at the China's Wine List of the Year Awards 2025 *Palace Garden Retains the Recognition of Macau's Best Wine List*

(Macau, 20 October 2025) SJM Resorts, S.A. (“SJM”) achieved remarkable results at the China's Wine List of the Year Awards 2025, taking home a total of 10 accolades, including nine “3 Glass Award” distinctions and one Best Wine List award. The strong showing underscores SJM's deep commitment to wine list curation, sommelier development and team training, reaffirming its long-standing leadership in professional F&B excellence and reinforcing Macau's prominence within the regional gastronomic landscape.

Nine of SJM's restaurants have been honoured with the prestigious “3 Glass Award,” including Robuchon au Dôme, The Eight, The Kitchen, and Casa Don Alfonso at Grand Lisboa Macau; and Palace Garden, Zuicho, Mesa by José Avillez, Don Alfonso 1890, and Hua Ting at Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau. Notably, Palace Garden was again awarded “Best Wine List – Macau SAR,” recognised for its refined curation and elevated wine experience—setting a new benchmark for premium wine lists in the city.

Ms. Daisy Ho, Managing Director of SJM, remarked, “Over the years, SJM has built a diverse and sophisticated wine programme, anchored by one of the most extensive wine cellars in Asia and supported by a highly trained sommelier team. Our sommeliers possess deep knowledge of the provenance and cultural narratives behind each label, and excel at creative pairing to enrich each dining experience with meaningful depth. Through these efforts, we hope to give multi-dimensional expression to Macau's designation and global image as a UNESCO ‘Creative City of Gastronomy.’”

Now in its 13th edition, the China's Wine List of the Year Awards are widely regarded as the “Oscars of the Chinese wine list industry.” The Awards are judged by a panel of leading sommeliers and industry experts from across Asia, who evaluate entries across various dimensions, including list depth, stylistic diversity, price fairness, and pairing logic. The Awards serve as a benchmark of quality and influence within the industry.

The awards ceremony was held during the “SJM Asia Top Sommelier Summit 2025,” a five-day event featuring international sommelier accreditation programme, masterclasses, wine carnival, industry competitions and themed forums, attracting over 250 sommeliers and F&B professionals from across Asia to Macau. The event not only facilitated cross-regional exchange, but also demonstrated Macau's exceptional MICE capability for high-level international events, reinforcing its positioning as a “World Centre of Tourism and Leisure” and further cementing its reputation as a globally connected cosmopolitan hub.

Looking ahead, SJM will continue to work closely with international organisations, invest in talent development, and drive “Gastronomy + Tourism” integration. Through innovative and diverse food-and-wine experiences, SJM aims to attract more

international travellers and further elevate Macau’s appeal and global stature as a “Creative City of Gastronomy.”
