Press Conference on 2025 CTA Tour SJM Professional Finals (Macau) and National Tennis Championships is Held in Beijing

(Beijing, 20 October 2025) The 2025 CTA Tour SJM Professional Finals (Macau) and National Tennis Championships press conference was held in Beijing. The event was announced to take place at the Macau Tennis Academy from December 1 to 7. China's top tennis players will gather in Macau to contend for the title.

CTA Tour was established in 2020, and SJM Resorts, S.A. ("SJM") successfully brought the year-end finals to Macau in the following years, serving as the title sponsor for five years in a row. After five years of meticulous development, the event has become an annual sporting spectacle for Macau, not only showcasing its enhanced expertise in mega-event capacity and resource integration but also consistently strengthening Macau's strategic position within the sports landscape of the Greater Bay Area.

The press conference opened with the screening of the tournament's promotional video, conveying the passion and vitality of this prestigious tennis event. Numerous players, including Cui Jie, Te Rigele, Liu Fangzhou, Yang Zhaoxuan, Guo Hanyu, Wang Aoran sent video messages to congratulate the tournament. Distinguished guests attending the press conference included Mr. Ding Xianghua, Deputy Director of the Tennis Administrative Center of the General Administration of Sport of China; Ms. Ung Ioc Leng, President of the Macau Tennis Association; Mr. Wei Shengfan, General Manager of Chinese Tennis Sports of Beijing Co., Ltd. and Chairman of Beijing CTA Tour Sport Management Co., Ltd.; Ms. Li Na, General Manager of Chengdu Sports Event Industry Development Co., Ltd.

Mr. Ding Xianghua, Deputy Director of the Tennis Sports Management Center of the General Administration of Sport of China stated: "Since its establishment in 2020, CTA Tour has been committed to building a strong pipeline of tennis talent and promoting the sport of tennis. Looking ahead, we will continue to optimize the tournament system and promote the high-quality development of tennis in broader and deeper dimensions. Let us look forward to this December, when tennis athletes from across the country will gather in the vibrant city of Macau, writing a new chapter in legend with passion and sweat."

Serving as the title sponsor of the CTA Tour Professional Finals for five years in a row, Ms. Daisy Ho, Managing Director of SJM Resorts, S.A., delivered her speech via video message: "This year's Finals fall at a particularly meaningful moment, taking place between the National Games and the National Special Olympic Games. We hope the event will carry forward the nation's sporting momentum, inspire athletes to stay at their best for this historic occasion, and engage the Macau community, especially the younger generation, to rally behind tennis and support our country's sporting development."

Ms. Ung Ioc Leng, President of the Macau Tennis Association remarked: "Over the past four years, when the tournament was held in Macau, it received enthusiastic support from local residents, visitors, and media partners. This year's tournament will introduce distinctive highlights for athletes and visiting teams during their stay in Macau. We will enhance promotional outreach across the Greater Bay Area through comprehensive media exposure and continuous online promotion of tournament updates and key attractions while also offering complimentary gifts for Macau residents and tennis enthusiasts. It will bring tennis fans from different cities to Macau to watch the matches and witness the growth and development of tennis in China."

The event overview was presented at the press conference. The 2025 CTA Tour commenced in April from Huzhou followed by nationwide competition, the circuit will culminate in Macau this December. China's top tennis players will gather in Macau to contend at the year-end finals. The event will feature men's and women's singles and doubles, with sixteen singles players and eight doubles teams competing in round-robin group stages followed by knockout rounds.

Ticket information was also announced at the press conference. Tickets are now available for purchase via Go Out Mall and Damai platforms. Macau residents and local students are eligible for a 50% discount. An early bird 50% discount is available from now until November 30. Additionally, a group discount offering 60% off for purchases of 10 tickets provides a cost-effective option for fans attending together.



This year's tournament will not only attract China's top tennis players but also feature a variety of activities. Featured events including the National Family Cup Tennis Invitational Tournament, complimentary access to the tournament's "Interactive Gaming Zone", and visits to the interactive "Cultural & Creative Zone", alongside signature programs including the multi-year "Macau Special Olympics Interaction Camp" and "Dialogues with Outstanding Athletes" sharing session. Furthermore, the event integrates Macau's tourism resources by offering ticket holders exclusive discounts for tourism, dining, and retail across the city, encouraging both residents and visitors to immerse themselves in Macau culture.

Notably, the 2025 "Zheng Jie Cup" Elite Junior Tennis Training Camp will debut in Macau. A star-studded national coaching team, led by Zheng Jie and Zhang Yu, will deliver a professional training experience. Outstanding junior players from Macau will be invited to train alongside national elites, fostering Macau's junior tennis development.

Hosting the CTA Tour Professional Finals for the fifth year, Macau demonstrates its commitment to establishing itself as a "City of Sports" and deepening its integration into the Greater Bay Area development strategy. With the 15th National Games of the People's Republic of China held across the Greater Bay Area in November, this early December tennis spectacle in Macau will extend the nationwide sporting enthusiasm generated by the National Games, reinforcing the city's dedication to integrating "Sports and Tourism" and promoting economic diversification objectives.
