SJM and its Parent Company Achieve New MICHELIN Milestones in 2026

Two Restaurants at Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau Celebrate their Inaugural MICHELIN Stars

(Macau, 19 March 2026) — At the announcement of the *MICHELIN Guide Hong Kong Macau 2026*, where the latest list of starred restaurants was unveiled, SJM Resorts, S.A. (“SJM”) achieves another milestone for the SJM Group: Palace Garden and Don Alfonso 1890 at Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau each earned their first MICHELIN Star, while SJM’s parent company, Sociedade de Turismo e Diversões de Macau, S.A. (“STDm”) celebrates the reopening of L’Atelier de Joël Robuchon in Hong Kong with Two MICHELIN Stars at its new home in Landmark. Together, SJM and its parent company STDm, now boast eight MICHELIN Star-recognised establishments and a total of ten MICHELIN Stars —the most in Hong Kong and Macau.

A Historic Milestone

From refined Cantonese artistry and world-class Western haute cuisine to contemporary Italian dining and elevated Japanese kappo, our diverse portfolio reflects the richness of Macau’s unique East-meets-West gastronomic identity. We remain deeply committed to advancing the city’s global culinary stature and contributing to Macau’s reputation as one of Asia’s most dynamic and distinguished dining capitals.”

Newly Starred Excellence

Both being awarded their first MICHELIN Star, Palace Garden and Don Alfonso 1890 highlight Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau’s growing influence in fine dining. Palace Garden offers an immersive exploration of traditional Taishi cuisine, featuring refined signature dishes crafted with simmered supreme broths and exacting knife work. Don Alfonso 1890, the Macau outpost of the iconic family-owned Italian restaurant, showcases the culinary traditions of the Sorrento Peninsula and Amalfi Coast with a hallmark farm-to-table philosophy. The restaurant sources produce from its own Italian farm, Le Peracciole, complemented by premium seasonal ingredients, delivering an authentic taste of Southern Italy.



Enduring Icons

At Grand Lisboa Macau, Robuchon au Dôme and The Eight continue to anchor Macau’s fine-dining prestige, each maintaining Michelin recognition for an exceptional 18 consecutive years. Robuchon au Dôme—Macau’s only Three-MICHELIN-Starred Western restaurant—carries forward a legacy shaped by the group’s partnership with the late Chef Joël Robuchon. The Group’s culinary heritage continues into Hong Kong, where L’Atelier de Joël Robuchon, operated by Lisboa Food & Wines Limited (Hong Kong) under STDM, has unveiled its new home at Landmark. The restaurant marks a stellar return to the city’s dining stage with Two MICHELIN Stars, reaffirming the Group’s leading role in advancing gastronomic excellence in both Hong Kong and Macau.

Meanwhile, The Eight, SJM’s home-grown Cantonese fine-dining brand and a Two-MICHELIN-Starred restaurant, continues to embody the artistry, heritage, and cultural depth of Cantonese cuisine on the international stage.

An Elevating Portfolio

Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau continues to strengthen its Michelin-starred portfolio. Centred on the refined artistry of kappo cuisine, Zuicho retains its one-Michelin-star status, while Mesa by José Avillez earns its first Michelin-Selected designation in 2026. Helmed by partner Portugal’s first Two-MICHELIN-Starred Chef José Avillez, Mesa blends contemporary Portuguese cuisine with a “Casual Fine Dining” philosophy and exceptional mixology craftsmanship. Meanwhile, The Kitchen at Grand Lisboa Hotel continues to hold its Michelin-Selected recognition, further enriching SJM’s diverse and award-winning culinary offering.
