**SJM Small Dragon Boat Teams Dominate Open and Women's  
Categories on Day One of the  
“2026 SJM Macao International Dragon Boat Races”**

(Macao, 13 June 2026) The highly anticipated “2026 SJM Macao International Dragon Boat Races” has officially kicked off at the Nam Van Lake Nautical Centre, with thrilling events scheduled for 13, 14, and 19 June. The prestigious event is jointly organised by SJM Resorts, S.A., the Sports Bureau of the Macao SAR Government, and the Dragon Boat Association of Macao, China, and co-organised by the Municipal Affairs Bureau and the Public Administration and Civil Service Bureau.

On the opening day, six dedicated SJM teams took to the water to compete in the Small Dragon Boat Races. The lineup featured SJM Golden Jubilee A, SJM Golden Jubilee B, SJM Prosperous and SJM Prosperous B in the Open Category, alongside SJM Lotus A and SJM Lotus B competing in the Women’s Category.

SJM’s senior management was present at the venue to show their full support, cheering on the athletes as they secured a double crown triumph. SJM Golden Jubilee A and SJM Lotus A clinched the championship in the Macao Small Dragon Boat Race Open Category (200m) and the Macao Small Dragon Boat Race Women’s Category (200m) respectively. Meanwhile, SJM Golden Jubilee B and SJM Prosperous also took second and sixth place in the Macao Small Dragon Boat Race Open Category (200m).

Throughout the fierce competition, the athletes demonstrated remarkable skill, resilience, and synergy. Their spectacular performances on the water perfectly embodied Macau’s dynamic spirit as a vibrant “City of Sports.”
