**Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau Officially Opens its Doors,

It is our conviction that this Resort will further promote the city's role in East-West cultural exchange, and attract a new generation of visitors who seek authenticity, originality and a unique experience."

In the first phase, the flagship Grand Lisboa Palace Macau, the largest of the three hotel towers in the Resort, is open to guests. Each of its 1,350 contemporary, Chinoiserie-inspired guestrooms pays tribute to the long tradition of Sino-Western cultural exchange in Macau. Other features include a variety of enticing dining options along with a host of other wellness and MICE facilities. This will be followed by a rolling launch throughout 2021 and beyond, with additional facilities and offerings in dining, shopping and leisure being continually added to the Resort's lifestyle sensation.

Acknowledging the hard work of Grand Lisboa Palace's team members, an opening rally was held yesterday at the employee dining room, where Ms. Daisy Ho thanked the team members on behalf of the company for their unwavering dedication and efforts in making the vision of



Grand Lisboa Palace come alive. The Directors of SJM raised a toast to the staff for their role in turning the project into a reality.
