## Maro Engel Crowned Champion of the First SJM Macau GT Cup – FIA GT World Cup

(Macau, 22 November 2015) The SJM Macau GT Cup – FIA GT World Cup, title sponsored by Sociedade de Jogos de Macau, S.A. ("SJM"), held its finale today with Maro Engel of Germany winning the first FIA GT World Cup.

The finale of the SJM Macau GT Cup – FIA GT World Cup started at 12:55 pm today as drivers competed along long straights and twisty corners, including the world-renowned Lisboa Bend. Germany's Maro Engel won the race, René Rast took second, and Stefan Mücke, third. Mercedes-Benz earned the inaugural FIA GT World Cup for Manufacturers.
