SJM Theodore Racing Triumphs in Round Three of 2025 Lamborghini Super Trofeo Asia

- Macau's Charles Leong and Ireland's Alex Denning take their fourth win of the season
- Championship lead further extended for SJM Theodore Racing after hectic second race in Fuji

(Macau, 7 July 2025) Supported by SJM Resorts, S.A. ("SJM"), iconic Asian motorsports team SJM Theodore Racing achieved their fourth win of the season after only six races in the 2025 Lamborghini Super Trofeo Asia ("LSTA") round three event in Japan. Macau's homegrown driver Charles Leong Hon Chio and teammate Alex Denning from Ireland secured second place in race one of the Fuji double header before clinching victory in the hectic race two, showcasing their determination on the track. This win further solidifies SJM Theodore Racing's position at the top of the championship standings as they head to round four in Korea next month.

I'm really very happy for everyone in the team and I'd like to say a huge thanks to SJM Theodore Racing again. We're looking forward to the rest of the season. Leading the championship going to Inje everything is very positive. We've extended our lead again and yeah, it's getting there."

Denning said: "As I always say, I judge the performance rather than the outcome and we are happy, really really happy with both the performance and the outcome there. It was probably one of the few races where it completely went to plan, so we're absolutely delighted. The season concludes in Italy at Misano from 6 to 7 November, which will host both the final LSTA round of the year and the annual Lamborghini Super Trofeo World Finals—a season-closing showdown between Super Trofeo competitors from the European, North American and Asian series.
